

• Financial Puzzle

Hennessy's Haunted House

Hennessy's House hides in the densely ivy-smothered woods on the outskirts of your county. As it is one of the oldest boarding schools in Ireland, tours are given daily and your teacher decides to bring your class, showing what life was like in schools in the past.

This imposing grey granite building, built in 1881 by John Hennessy, was mysteriously closed and abandoned in 1981, when a series of strange and spooky incidents took place at the school. Some pupils reported seeing books flying across the library when there was no one else in the room. One teacher even told a story about hearing a peculiar noise while sitting in the library. At first she thought it was the wind but as she listened carefully, she could hear the strange ghostly whispering of 'open, treasure, open'. It was all too much, so the pupils were all returned to their homes, the teachers found new jobs and the school was closed.

As you walk up the avenue you notice how creepy the building looks, covered in ivy, just like the woods surrounding it. The large wooden door opens and you are led in by a guide who explains the history of the house and then leaves you to explore the house.

When you wander into the library, you knock over an old wooden chest sitting on a table and the lid swings open. Immediately you hear the door lock behind you. You scramble to unlock the door but as hard as you try, you can't open it. Suddenly you hear a loud thud behind you, as you turn around, you see a red velvet-covered back book fall to the ground. You pick up the book and as you do, a piece of paper drifts from the book to the floor.
