Write to Someone in a Nursing
or Care Home



Now more than ever, it is important to show our family, friends, and our community how much we care.



Many people who are living in nursing or care homes across Ireland are not able to see or talk to their friends and family during this time. You can spread a little joy and Send Love by writing a kind letter to brighten their day.



As part of our Community Focus Initiative, An Post will help you to Send Love to others in your community by ensuring free delivery of all card and letter mail posted to and from residents of nursing and care homes.

Write FREEPOST on the top right of the letter, where a stamp would usually be placed. An Post will carry cards, letters, large envelopes and packets weighing up to 2KG without a postage stamp!



Where do I start?

1. Ask someone at home to help you choose a nursing or care home to write to.
2. Write down the name and address. You'll need this later.
3. Get some paper and a pen/pencil!



What should I include in my letter?

It may seem strange at first, to write to someone you have never met before. You want to:

- Let them know who you are and why you are writing.
- Tell them something about yourself: how old you are or what hobbies and interests you have.
- Ask them some questions. What would you like to know? It can be something simple, like what is your favourite thing to do for fun?
- Let them know that you'd love to hear back from them.
- You can even draw some pictures on your letter if you'd like!
